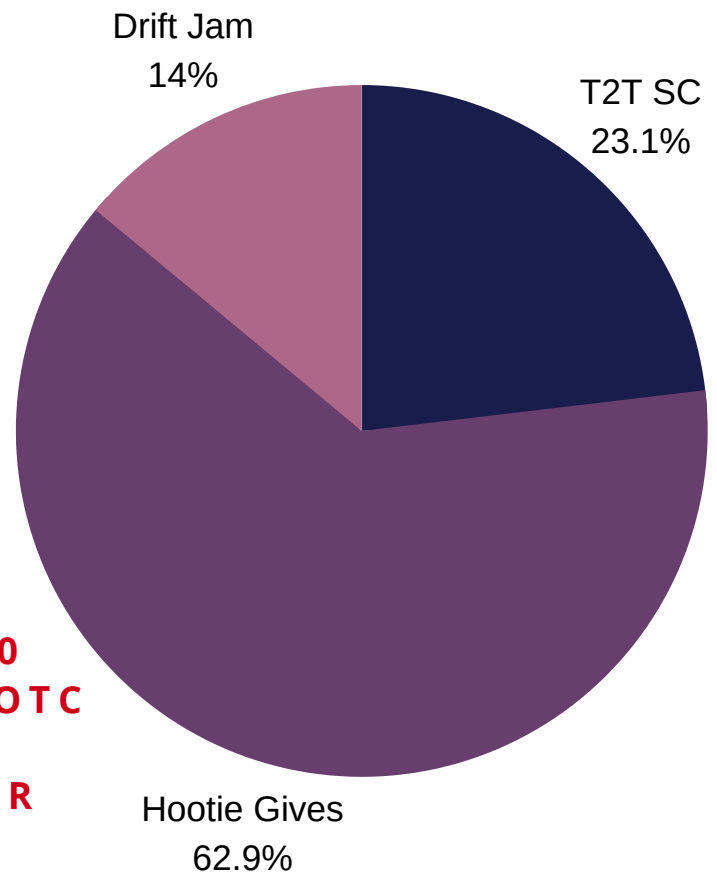

THE FLAG AND EAGLE WING ON THE SEAL MOMENTARILY BREAK THE CIRCLE AS THE EAGLE WING OVERLAPS THE CIRCLE AS IT DESCENDS TO LIFT THE FALLEN FROM THE CARNAGE. THE BEAMS TRANSCEND INTO UPWARD TURNED, CROSSED SWORDS WHICH REPRESENT READINESS FOR BATTLE OR CONFLICT AND MILITARY MIGHTINESS.

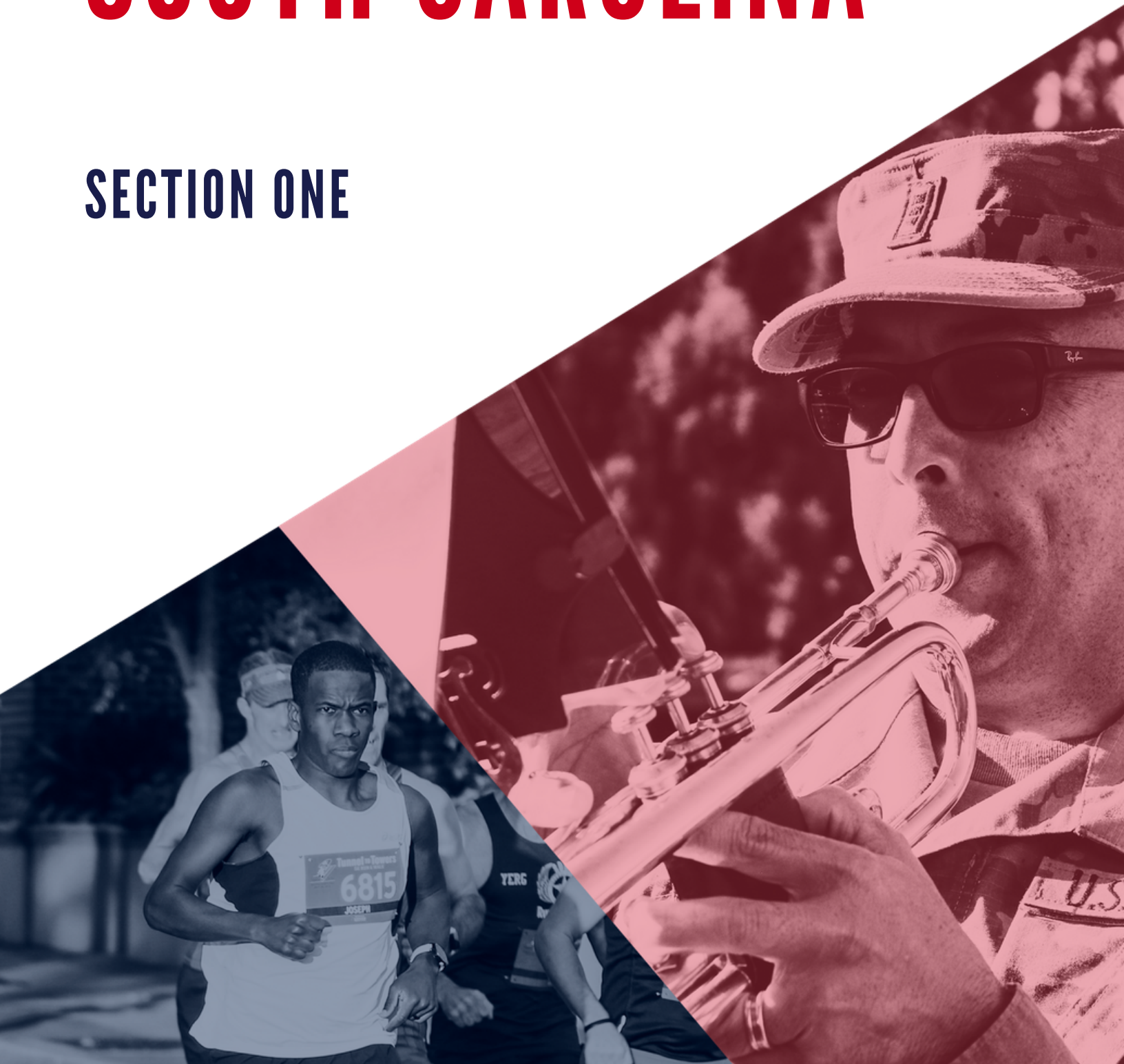

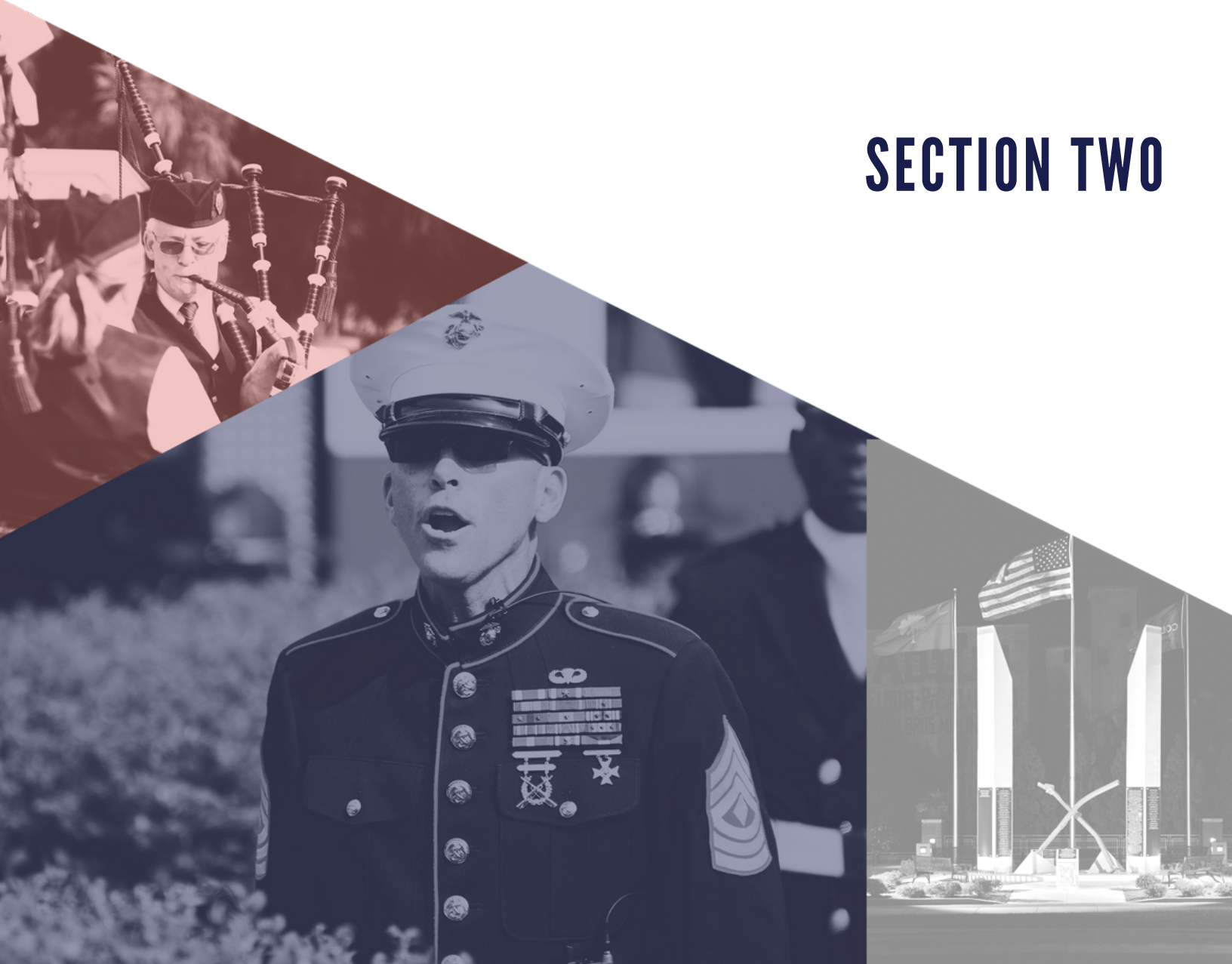

ERECTED IN 2011, THE COLUMBIA 9/11 MILITARY SERVICE MEMBERS & FIRST RESPONDERS MEMORIAL IS A SHINING BEACON OF REMEMBRANCE FOR OUR FALLEN FIRST RESPONDERS FROM SOUTH CAROLINA. LOCATED AT THE COLUMBIA METROPOLITAN CONVENTION CENTER, THE MONUMENT IS COMPRISED OF TWO STEEL BEAMS FROM THE WORLD TRADE CENTER AND TWO GRANITE PILLARS ETCHED WITH THE NAMES OF THE 57 SOUTH CAROLINA FIRST RESPONDERS KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY SINCE 2001. STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Honoring our Heroes' Children Scholarship seeks to provide educational assistance to children, who have at least (1) one parent currently serving or who previously served in the U.S. Armed Forces or have at least (1) one parent who volunteers or is employed as a First Responder (Fire/EMS/911/Law Enforcement). The scholarship must be used for higher education expenses for a student who will attend a two or four-year university.

Since 2017, the 9/11 Remembrance Foundation has given three scholarships, totaling over \$6,000 towards furthering students' higher education.

The 9/11 Remembrance Foundation of South Carolina and its board members are committed to serving the community through events both in and out of the foundation. Below are our 2019 initiatives through our team.

CENTENNIAL PARK PROGRAM AT FORT JACKSON

9/11 Remembrance Foundation Chairman Dan Hennigan assisted with the Gateway To The Army Foundation (GTТА) in their progress towards the finishing of Centennial Park at Fort Jackson. Hennigan, who serves on the Gateway To The Army board, as well as 9/11 Vice Chair David Kerr, assisted in securing a grant from the Home Depot Foundation for over \$7500 towards shrubs, landscaping, and other materials needed for further construction of Centennial Park.



COLUMBIA'S FISHER HOUSE

Jared Evans, Director of USC Outreach & Veterans Initiatives, is in his second year of hosting the USC Veterans' Day 5K, with all proceeds benefitting Columbia's Fisher House Project. Columbia's Fisher House at the Dorn VA Medical Center will provide complementary lodging for military members as a loved ones receive medical care. Evans, in assistance with USC Student Government and several other organizations have raised over 19-thousand dollars in the last two years towards Fisher House.
